Organizers may engage with the media, distribute educational materials, or host outreach activities to promote environmental stewardship and encourage long-term behavior change.
- 7.Post-Cleanup Evaluation and Celebration: After the clean-up activities are completed, organizers may conduct a post-cleanup evaluation to assess the impact of the event, gather feedback from volunteers, and identify areas for improvement. Volunteers may also gather for a celebration or appreciation event to recognize their efforts and celebrate the success of the clean-up drive.
