

Title: Menstrual Health & Hygiene

Date: 28/08/2022

Timing: 11:00 a.m. onwards

Mode: Online Google Meet

The aim of the webinar is to break down the cultural taboo surrounding menstruation and to create a safe and inclusive environment for people of all genders to discuss and learn about the menstrual cycle. The stigma and shame associated with menstruation often prevent people from seeking information and support when they need it. Saloni Kalambe and Dhruvi Kothari who are menstrual health educators at paddling foundation explained the importance of hygiene. By creating a space where individuals can discuss their experiences and learn from one another, the webinar was meant to promote an open and honest views about menstruation. In addition to providing accurate information about the menstrual cycle, the webinar also addressed common myths and misconceptions. Many of these myths are based on cultural beliefs and have no scientific basis. It also aimed to encourage men to participate in the conversation about menstruation. The impact of the webinar on the menstrual cycle was very significant in breaking the stigma and shame surrounding menstruation. It increased awareness and understanding; it provided accurate information about the menstrual cycle, its importance, and how it affects women's physical and emotional health. It also addressed the various myths and misconceptions surrounding menstruation. It helped to increase awareness and understanding among participants and reduce the misinformation that contributes to the stigma surrounding menstruation. One of the important impacts of the webinar was that it reduced the shame and stigma associated with menstruation among men.

The feedback from the event was worth listening to, and we were appreciated for creating a safe and inclusive space. Attendees appreciated snd said that the webinar created a safe and inclusive space for people of all genders to discuss and learn about the menstrual cycle. It increased knowledge and understanding; they gained a better understanding. They learned about the various myths and misconceptions surrounding menstruation and how to debunk them with scientific evidence. They felt empowered by the knowledge and understanding they have gained information about their bodies and the menstrual cycle. Participants expressed gratitude for addressing a taboo topic that is often ignored or dismissed in many societies. By normalising conversations about menstruation, the webinar helped reduce the shame and stigma associated with it and created a more inclusive and supportive community for all.
