Report of the activity conducted to identify advance and slow learners (AY 2022-23)

At the beginning of academic year 2022-23, to identify slow and advance learners for TYBSc (Mathematics) class, department of mathematics decided to conduct tests in regular interval in the first month (June 2022). Total 4 tests were conducted. Based on their performance in these tests, we identify 10 slow learner students out of 36 students. Before deciding their ability, we observe their performances in the previous three academic years. We found that these 10 students have scored excellent marks in their previous examinations. So, we conclude that these 10 students are not actually slow learners but they were not regularly attending classes or not studying properly and regularly. Therefore, we conducted peer-teaching, group discussion activities to enhance their ability and were regular touch with their parents.
