Transportation:

In case you arrive at Seville Airport, we recommend taking the airport bus (EA) or a taxi. The bus stop is located on your right after leaving the terminal. Tickets can be purchased on the bus for 4 EUR per person. Wearing a mask is required. The bus leaves approximately every 15 minutes. Here is the schedule: https://reddelineas.tussam.es/?lang=es#. Get off after approximately 25 minutes at the bus stop Luis de Morales (number 137), from which it is a short walk to the hotel. Alternatively, an airport taxi costs 31 EUR. If you arrive by train, the main station (Santa Justa) is within walking distance from the hotel.
