Branches

Branches are where account holder come to deposit their waste.

Since students are the focus, the branches are educational institutions. Students will deposit waste only in their own Branch and not another one. (Register your Educational Institute as a Branch)

Indicative functioning of Branches

The Educational Institutes which agree to open branches will function once in a week only on a designated day and hours. The institute will provide a small space consisting of two tables and a few chairs to the Branch staff to sit and accept the deposits from the account holders. They could need an electricity connection for their devices and also a space protected from the weather elements. The institutes will also provide a storage space for storing the collected waste which will be cleared once in a month.

The waste stored at the Branches is collected once in a month and transported to the City Depot. At the City Depot waste from a number of Branches is stored. At the City Depot the waste will get sorted and baled and ready for final disposal either in road making or a cement kiln.

The complete system is run on an IT backend where all the deposits by the Account Holders are recorded accurately and available to the account holders for viewing in an e-passbook online. The Branch Managers have logins which allows them to access the system and make deposits.

Branch Managers

Just like Account Holders, Branch Managers are integral to ensure that the system works smoothly. Branch Managers are individuals who take pride to volunteer in supporting the functioning of a particular branch. Ideally this should be an institute or location which they are already are an integral part of. Branch Managers could do either or all of these roles

1) Accept the waste and login the details into the system for each account holder

2) Train other volunteers to service the account holders

3) Ensure that the collected waste is stored securely within the Branch premises.

4) Coordinate with City Coordinators to ensure that the waste is collected once in a month

5) Keep a monthly display of the waste collected at the Branch to make the account holders appreciate what they have managed to divert from the dumping grounds.

6) Any other task as required.

City Managers

City Managers will oversee the functioning of various branches in their City. This is a voluntary role currently and those who volunteer can choose how much time and effort they may like to contribute. There can be multiple City Managers and it is expected that they contribute within themselves.


Rewards and Appreciation

1. Conduct awareness sessions amongst students and staff about Safai Bank of India- Project by Mumbai Sustainability Centre and Kulkarni Foundation, on Multilaminated Plastic (MLP) waste and its relationship with climate change and Global warming.
2. Promote knowledge on Plastic Pollution and provide training on segregation of plastic, especially MLPs, amongst students and college staff.
3. Sensitise and involve students from the college/ institute for promoting the concept of environmental related projects.
4. Help in the collection and disposal of MLPs through Mumbai Sustainability Centre.
5. Any environmental activity/ Project in consultation with the College.

Roles and Responsibilities of College:

1. The College will make arrangements for the awareness lectures.
2. The students and staff will actively participate in the collection of MLP plastic waste.
3. The College will provide appropriate storage space for the collected MLPs till its disposal to MSC.
4. Environment based projects being a part of college environmental activity and so it will be monitored on a regular basis by NCC/ NSS/ DLLE, general students and faculty members. This is an ongoing project in force for one year of this academic year.
5. College will nominate a contact person to whom the activity report will be submitted on a regular monthly basis.

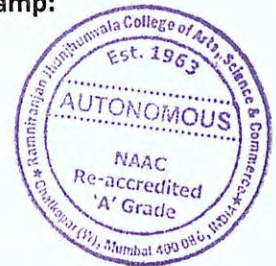

SAFAI BANK OF RJ COLLEGE (SAFAI WARRIORS)

The Safai Bank of R J College as a part of Swacchta Ambassadors and in association with the Safai Bank of India has been formed since October 2018 but became active since January 2019. In the year 2019-20 about 4-5 Departments and now presently in 2020-21 there are about 16 Departments of our college associated with this initiative. From the Department there are Teachers who have volunteered to be a part of this initiative and also involved in guiding and helping the students in the systematic collection and deposition of Plastic, especially Multi-laminated Plastic (MLPs). There are core student representatives appointed who constantly interact and keep records with the Class representatives. These class representatives are the ultimate important part of the ladder who are in direct contact with the student volunteers who collect and submit their MLPs.

During the lockdown since March 2020, student volunteers, the core representatives and also teachers from various departments have been continuing with their drive and depositing the MLPs at the college as when possible. **Till now, the Safai Bank unit of R J college has deposited about 113515 with the central depository of Safai Bank of India and placed within the top 10 depositor institutions involved with Safai Bank of India.** Many student volunteers have collected the MLPs in their house but due to restrictions in travelling as well as the infection rate has held them back in coming to the college but nevertheless, these warriors have been making efforts to deposit in the college by some way or the other. **Since August 2020, the Safai Bank unit of R J College has deposited with the central depository about 21,186 MLPs and another around 8,000 MLPs have been collected within the college and its deposition with central depository is pending.**
