A student of Ancient Indian Numismatics, Amiteshwar Jha (b. 1963) became seriously interested in Indian Numismatics after doing his post-graduation in History from Delhi University in 1985. He joined Indian Numismatic, Historical and Cultural Research Foundation (earlier known as Institute of Research in Numismatic Studies), Anjaneri, Nasik in 1988 and since then has been involved in research and teaching in Indian Numismatics. Since 1999, he has been working at the same Institute as Director (Research). In between, he also worked for about a year during 1997-98 at the Department of Coins & Medals, British Museum, London as Hirayama Curator.

Recipient of many awards and fellowships like The Chand A & Z Fellowship for the Study of Indian Numismatics from Royal Numismatic Society, Great Britain in 2001, Kraay Travel Fellowship from Ashmolean Museum, University of Oxford in 2004, Neil Kreitman Fund Fellowship from Royal Numismatic Society, Great Britain in 2005, he was also awarded Lifetime Achievement Award in 2008 by the Numismatic Society of India and Indian Coin Society. In 2015, the South Indian Coin Society awarded him its Parmeshwari Lal Gupta Medal, in 2016 the Collectors Society of Numismatic & Rare Items, Nasik felicitated him with Lifetime Achievement Award, and The Bombay Coin Society also awarded him with its Mudra Ratna Puraskar in 2016.

His main area of research is ancient Indian numismatics and he has written a number of papers on many diverse series of ancient Indian coins besides writing two books and editing two volumes. Apart from research, he is also interested in spreading knowledge about Indian coins amongst students and general public through training courses, lectures, and books. Since 1988, he has been the Project Director of the training course of the Institute called **Workshop on Practical Guide to the Fundamentals of Indian Numismatics**. He has also devised some other practical training oriented courses on Indian Numismatics and has been conducting them at the Institute. He has also conducted Introductory Awareness Workshop on Indian coins to educate the students about the importance of coins for our history and as our heritage at a large number of colleges/ schools/ institutions / groups. His book entitled *Bharatiya Sikke: Ek Aitihasik Parichaya* in Hindi first published in 2003 was also an attempt in this direction. This book was also awarded **Pt. Bhagwanlal Indraji Medal** for the best numismatic publication for the year 2003 by the **Indian Coin Society**. Working towards the objective of making young students aware about our numismatic heritage and its importance, he has also conceptualized, designed and brought out many informative coin posters and coin card games, which have become very popular.

He also helped build a small money museum at the Institute. Now under his stewardship, this museum has been redeveloped into a bigger museum. Under his leadership, during the last 6-7 years, the INHCRF has built a detailed documentation of about 200,000 coins belonging to several institutional collections for the National Mission on Monuments and Antiquities, Government of India, and another 75,000 coins belonging to different collections.

Besides *Bharatiya Sikke: Ek Aitihasik Parichay* (2003), he has written another book (with Dilip Rajgor) entitled *Studies in the Coinage of the Western Ksatrapas* (IIRNS, Nasik, 1994) and also edited the following two books:

- 1. Papers presented at the Colloquium on *Medieval Indian Coinages: A Historical and Economic Perspective*, Anjaneri (Nashik), 2001.
- 2. Foreign Coins Found in the Indian Sub-continent (with Dr. David W. MacDowall), IIRNS Publications, Anjaneri (Nashik), 2004.

He has been editing *Numismatic Digest*, the annual Research Journal of the institute, first as Associate Editor (1988-2002) and then as Editor (since 2002). He also edited a newsletter called *HRNS Newsline* between April 1999 and January 2007, when the publication of the newsletter was stopped.
