

BRIEF REPORT: A poster event titled 'Animal of the environment' was organized by Mr. Deepak Poojary for students of S.Y.B.Sc on World Environment Day on the 5th of June 2020. A total of 24 students participated in the event.

The students were asked to prepare a poster in the form of a single slide. The slide carried a picture of the animal which they feel is a very important animal. Along with the picture, students also wrote a short description about the animal and also the reasons to justify it as a significant animal.

Students submitted a range of animals from the smallest earthworms to the largest vultures. The aim of this activity was to sensitize the students about the significance of each animal in the environment.
