### Department of History

### Report of Debate Competition

Department of History organized a Debate *Competition* on the theme *World Peace: Need for Disarmament* on August 7, 2021. The aim of the event was to improve language and communication skills and develop confidence to present and defend one's views. The event commemorated the 1945 nuclear bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Dr. Meher Mistry made a presentation showcasing the impact of the bombings on Japan. A documentary of United Nations highlighting the need for disarmament was screened. It aimed to sensitize the students on the topic of war and the current competition for becoming a nuclear power. 8 students participated in the debate. Each of them made a plausible cause for their stand. The debate brought out both sides of disarmament and war. Apart from individually presenting their side of the debate, the participants also engaged in an animated discussion that enhanced the intensity of the debate. It brought out the competitive spirit among them. Dr. Janhavi Bhagwat, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology judged the competition. Her comments guided the participants for presenting themselves better in a debate. The first Prize went to Ms. Sakshi Mohile from SYBCOM. She was articulate and strong in her presentation. Ms. Sujita Maurya from TYBA received the Second Prize. Her clarity impressed the judge. The event had 21 student beneficiaries:
