

MSME stands for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise. It was introduced by the Government of India in agreement with the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act of 2006. As per this act, MSMEs are the enterprises involved in the production, processing or preservation of goods and commodities. Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, coined as MSMEs, have come to become the Indian economy's major pillar of foundation. MSMEs enable citizens of a nation to venture out on their own and in turn, give back to society by creating new jobs and diversifying an area's gross domestic <u>production(GDP)</u>. They constantly support the up gradation of technology, infrastructure development, and trigger the modernization of the country and our society as a whole. In terms of numbers, micro, small and medium enterprises contribute a staggering 30% to the country's GDP, and around 45% of the manufacturing output, and approximately 48% of the country's exports. MSMEs are an important sector for the Indian economy and have contributed immensely to the country's socio-economic development.

It not only generates employment opportunities but also works hand-in-hand towards the development of the nation's backward and rural areas. After agriculture, MSME is the second-largest employment provider in India. Presently, there are nearly 56 million such enterprises in various industries, employing close to 124 million people. Of these, almost 14% are women-led enterprises, and close to 60% are based in rural areas. In all, the MSME sector accounts for 45% of merchandise exports 8% of India's GDP. Due to this, the MSME sector is called the growth engine of the nation. Strengthening them would have multiple impetuses hoposting economy and employment as well as mitigating issues of migrating skilled, unskilled workers and professionals to metro cities.


