

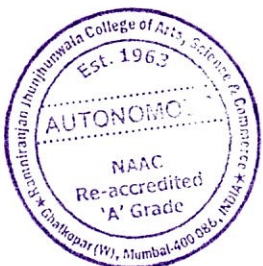
The topics for the competition were as follows:-

Handle with care plastic is everywhere

Nowadays, Plastic has become one the major problem. Plastic can be used for almost anything either liquid or solid. Moreover, it comes in different forms which we can easily mold. Furthermore, we see that plastic is a non-biodegradable material. It does not leave the face of the Earth. We cannot dissolve plastic in land or water, it remains forever . PVC/Polyvinyl Chloride ,is consider as a most hazardous plastic.

Plastics era – came in 1907, with the invention of Bakelite by the Belgian-born American Leo Baekeland. It was the first synthetic plastic – the first to be derived not from plants or animals, but from fossil fuels . Plastic was mass produced after the second world war and again after the 1960s & 1970s.

Plastic present in the following places causing pollution and disturbing the ecosystem of that place .

In ocean:- Plastic present on sea shores harm to the aquatic animals because , a layer of algae and microbes build up on the plastic and make it smell like food. Plastics smell like food to turtles after they have been in the ocean for a while, a study has found. The build-up of algae on ocean plastic causes the rubbish to give off the aroma of food for loggerhead turtles . Thousands of seabirds and sea turtles, seals and other marine mammals are killed each year after ingesting plastic or getting entangled in it. Endangered wildlife like Hawaiian monk seals and Pacific loggerhead sea turtles are among nearly 700 species that eat and get caught in plastic litter.

On land : presence of plastic in field ,on grasslands or in forests causing harm to the pet animals as well as wild animals . Plastics have been consumed by land-based animals, including elephants, hyenas, zebras, tigers, camels, cattle, and other large mammals, in some cases causing death. Tests have also confirmed liver and cell damage and disruptions to reproductive systems, prompting some species, such as oysters, to produce fewer eggs.

Burning of plastic waste increase the risk of heart disease, aggravates respiratory ailments such as asthma and emphysema and cause rashes, nausea or headaches, and damages the nervous system.

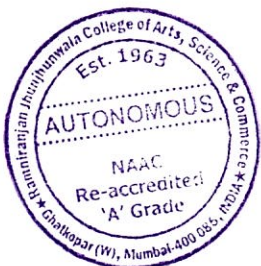
