




## REPORT – XXVIII DR D V AMONKAR MEMORIAL INTERCOLLEGIATE ELOCUTION COMPETITION-

2022

This year the initiation for the competition started in July 2022. Accordingly, flyers were prepared and posted on various whatsapp groups of college students as well as Teacher groups of different colleges.

The Topics for the competition were:

1. Natural Flavour production by Biotransformation
2. Endemic plants of Western Ghats and strategies for their conservation.
3. Role of community seed banking in Germplasm conservation.
4. Green Infrastructure for Urban cities – Scope and challenges.
5. Precision Agriculture

46 participants from 14 different colleges belonging to UG and PG sections registered themselves for the event through the Google Form link provided.

Due to the prevalent COVID-19 situation, the Preliminary and Semi- final rounds were held in online mode through ZOOM platform.

Due to the large number of participation, the Preliminary round was conducted in 3 sessions-

- 1) Schedule 1- Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, 3 pm onwards
- 2) Schedule 2- 2 Parallel sessions on Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, 3 pm onwards

Online Orientation/ Demo session for the participants, to get them acquainted with Share feature of the Zoom Platform, was held on Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, 4 pm onwards. Instructions, including the rules and the scoring pattern, for the event were also shared with the participants on this Platform.

Probably due to examination period or otherwise, of the total 46 registered participants, overall 20 participated and gave their presentation of which 10 were selected for the Semi-final round.

This year the semi- final round was held online on zoom platform on Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, 9:30 am onwards The Panel of Judges for the semi- final round included Dr Suchandra Dutta and Dr Karishma Rajbhar.

In the semi- final round, of the 10 participants, 5 participants were selected for the final round.

The final round was held in offline mode within the college campus in MPS Sabhagruha. The final round followed by the Declaration of result and Prize Distribution Ceremony was held on Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 3:00 pm onwards.

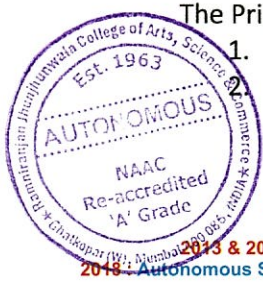

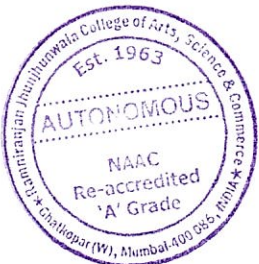

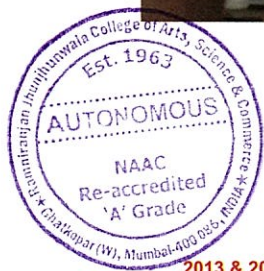
