BIODATA OF SPEAKER

Biodata of Resource person

Dr. Simin Patel, better known as Miss Bombaywalla, is a historian of Bombay. She runs Bombaywalla Historical Works, a platform that creates awareness about Bombay's built environment and social history. Bombaywalla operates a blog, conducts historical walks and curates public history projects for various organisations.

Simin completed her PhD in the social history of the Parsi community of colonial Bombay from the University of Oxford (Balliol College) in 2015. She is currently working on a book on Bombay's iconic Irani cafes with photographer Hashim Badani for Roli Books.

While she was studying for her masters in English Literature she attended a class - Modern South Asian History by Prof Ravi Ahuja - that piqued her interest. She had engaged with themes of post-colonialism, gender, nationalism through interpreting Indian and international fiction but two new books on Bombay by Jim Masselos and Sandip Hazareesingh, that she read for the class, inspired her to focus on colonial Bombay.

She feels that her Parsi heritage played a large role in her interest in the city and the historic structures there. She has studied, lived and worked in some of Bombay's finest buildings and as the years pass her relationship with the city is constantly evolving.

Over the course of her studies for her Doctorate in Philosophy, she had collated a lot of information about Bombay of the 1860's and wanted to share her findings. With a few college friends from St. Xaviers, she started a blog in 2013 and from there, the journey to becoming Miss. Bombaywalla began.

Another one of her pet projects is a book on the iconic Irani cafes of the city in collaboration with photographer Hashim Badani for Roli Books. They spent over a year interviewing partners at various establishments and turned up some pretty unusual histories. Unfortunately they're keeping the details under wraps until nearer the date of publishing, but it promises to be a fascinating read.

REPORT

Histeria & Seminar

History, the 3 day History Festival of the History Association was held between February 8-11. 2019. All the competitions were based on the theme Celebrating Mumbai and were held at an intercollegiate level. The annual intercollegiate students' seminar was held on the first day February 8, on the theme Mumbai Folks, highlighting the contribution of the various communities of Mumbai. 14 student teams from 6 different colleges presented well researched papers on significant personalities, economic and political contribution, cultural evolution and other aspects of different communities such as Bohras, Kolis, Jews, Bhatias etc. Historian and blogger, Dr. Simin Patel, co - founder of Bombaywalla Historical Works Pvt. Ltd., was the Chief Guest for the seminar. She gave an interesting talk on the Persian Community of Mumbai and the Irani Cafes. She also judged the first session. Prof. Safina Rakhangi, Head of Department of History of Jai Hind College delivered a talk on the Social Composition of Mumbai in the 19th century and chaired the second session of the seminar. In all there were 57 students who benefitted from the seminar.

On February 9, Mumbai Monuments, model making competition was organized. Beautiful models of Mumbai's iconic heritage structures such as St. Thomas Cathedral, Khotachi Wadi etc. were made by 4 teams from 3 Colleges. In all 13 students participated. It was followed by Mumbai Folks- Fashion show competition. 7 teams from 5 colleges participated in the competition. Students walked the ramp elegantly in traditional attire of the communities represented by them and also gave a brief description about their costumes. In all 30 students participated. These were judged by Dr. Madhumita Bandyopadhyay. Mumbai Cuisines, a food history competition was held on February 11, 2019. It explored the varied and rich culinary history of the city. 13 participants from 4 Colleges presented delicious dishes with intriguing information about their history. It was judged by Mr. Prashant Nanaware, reputed journalist and blogger who writes columns on Food Culture. The audience enjoyed his talk on Mumbai's Food Culture. It was followed by a Treasure hunt based on quiz trivia related to the history of Mumbai. 40 students participated in this event. Other events like Mumbai Pix- a historical photography competition also met an enthusiastic response.19 students submitted their entries.In the Mumbai Verses Competition . These were judged by Prof. Steven Lobo of Political Science Department. 25 students submitted poems on their beloved city. These were judged by Dr. Neeta Chakravarty, Head, English Department, Dr. Mithilesh Sharma, Head, Hindi Department and Dr. Sneha Deuskar, Head, Department of Marathi.


