

Report

A two days National Webinar on "NAAC Accreditation, A first Step Towards Achieving Excellence In Quality Education" For Legal Education Colleges' was organized by Ramniranjan Jhunjhunwala College of Arts, Science and Commerce along with HVPS College of Law under the aegis of UGC Paramarsh Scheme on December 20 and 21, 2021.

The webinar began with a welcome address by Dr Himanshu Dawda of Ramniranjan Jhunjhunwala College of Arts, Science and Commerce. It was followed by address of Dr Usha Mukundan, Director, Hindi Vidya Prachar Samiti who explained the importance of the webinar.

Day 1

Session I

The session began with the address of resource person Dr Devender Kawade, Deputy Advisor, NAAC, Bengaluru. Dr Kawdey gave an overview of the NAAC process. He stated that quality education requires contribution from all stakeholders. The seven criteria are the core process that defines the NAAC process. NAAC provides both qualitative and quantitative metrics and the educational institution must strive to excel in all seven criteria.

The second resource person Dr Sujata Shanbaugh, Adviser NAAC, Bengaluru informed about the Data Validation and Verification process. Dr Sujata stated that seventy percent of the CGPA is derived from the quantitative metrics of the NAAC criteria hence it is a game changer. She said institutions must provide precise information required by DVV. As far as possible the institutional website must provide extensive information required by DVV for verification.

Session II

The Session II was conducted by Dr Usha Mukundan. Dr Mukundan spoke on Criteria I & II. Dr Mukundan said that criterion I refers to the academic practices of the institution in terms of providing different programme options and courses. These programmes and courses should be able to integrate knowledge existing at the global, national and local levels. Dr Mukundan said criterion II pertains to the efforts of an institution undertaken to serve students of different backgrounds and abilities, through effective teaching-learning experiences. She discussed the importance of both criteria in terms of curriculum design, development and planning and implementation.

Dr Vaishali Raikar elaborated on Criteria III which covers Research, Innovations and Extension. She said that criterion three seeks information on the policies, practices and outcomes of the institution, with reference to research, innovations and extension. It deals with the facilities provided and efforts made by the institution to promote a research culture.

Session III

Dr Nandini Vaz, Associate Professor and Head Department of Zoology Parvatibai Chowgule College of Arts & Science spoke on Criteria IV-Infrastructure and Learning Resources and Criteria V- Student Support and Progression. She said efficient use of the facilities available in an institution are essential to maintain the quality of academic and other programmes. Physical facilities play an important role in the success of the academic programme run by the institution. Physical infrastructures must benefit different stakeholders like students, teachers and staff. Labs, computers, seminar rooms, audio visual centers, LCDs contribute to the overall growth of the institution. It is important to maintain, augment and expand the facilities to meet future demands of the educational system. The Criterion V which is about Student Support and Progression focuses on the efforts undertaken by the institution to provide necessary assistance to students, to enable them to acquire meaningful experiences for learning at the campus and to facilitate their holistic development and progression.

Dr Bhushan Arekar spoke on Criterion VI. The criteria covers important aspects like Governance, Leadership and Management. He emphasized that institutions must undertake proactive measures to devise policies and practices in order to optimize the human resources, recruitment process, training for teaching and non teaching staff, performance appraisal and financial management. The role of leadership and its vision plays a crucial role in achieving the goals.

Professor Pooja Bharwaj discussed Criteria VII which refers to Institutional Values and Best Practices. She stated that educational institutions function as a part of the overall ecosystem of the country and hence it is imperative that they are responsive to emerging challenges and pressing issues at a national and global level. She said that according to NAAC manual for Affiliated/Constituent UG & PG Colleges this role of the institution is reflected in terms of the variety of programmes, activities and preferences (values) that it incorporates within its regular functioning. Additionally, every institution faces and resolves various kinds of internal pressures and situations while doing this. Some meaningful practices pertinent to such situations are evolved within the institution and these help smooth functioning and also lead to enhanced impact. Such practices which are evolved internally by the institution leading to improvements in any one aspect of its functioning – academic, administrative or organizational, - are recognized as "best practices".

The session was followed by interaction with the participants. Dr Usha Mukundan clarified the doubts raised by the participants. Dr Sneha Deuskar delivered the vote of thanks.
